


# Cathedral Window

15 inch finished

All decisions are made, everything is arranged. The wedding can officially begin.

Fin and Ophelia have decided on a simple wedding in the cathedral side chapel for 100 guests, and only 4 attendants each. With the smaller wedding, Agnes has been allowed to indulge in her passion for flowers. Phe and Agnes decided on white flowers, so the chapel is filled with white lilies in tall vases. There are roses and lilies on the alter, dark blue hangings shine against all the wooden pews. The wedding is in the late afternoon and the setting sun is filling the chapel with the rich colours from the stained glass windows.



Background: 8 – 2 inch by 5 inch rectangles  
4 – 2 inch by 3 ½ inch rectangles

Ruby Red: 1 – 3 ½ inch square |

Grass Green: 4 – 3 ½ inch squares

Royal Purple: 24 - 2 inch squares for connector corner  
4 - quarter square triangles cut from a 2 inch strip with a Quarter Square or Companion Angle Triangle Ruler ( or one 4 ½ inch square cut diagonally into 4 triangles)


Rich Gold: 4 – half square triangles from 3 ½ inch strip using a Half Square or Easy Angle Triangle Ruler (or 2 – 3 7/8 inch squares cut diagonally in half)  
4 – quarter square triangles cut from a 2 inch strip with a Quarter Square or Companion Angle Triangle Ruler (or one 4 ½ inch square cut diagonally into 4 triangles)  
8 – 2 inch squares for connector corners

Dark Blue: 4 – 2 inch squares


Sky Blue: 12 – quarter square triangles cut from a 2 inch strip with a Quarter Square or Companion Angle Triangle Ruler (or three 4 ½ inch squares cut diagonally twice for a total of 12 triangles)  
8 – 2 inch by 3 ½ inch rectangles

Building from the centre of the window out,

Sew 4 sky blue quarter square triangles to the Ruby Red square. Then add the large Gold half square triangles. Make sure this measures 6 ½ inches square




Sew two sky blue quarter square triangles, one purple triangle, and one yellow triangle into a square. Make 4 of these measuring 3 ½ inches square




Now use the sky blue rectangles, Purple and yellow connectors to make 4 flying geese pairs. Note that the pairs have to be mirror images! They must measure 2 inches by 3 ½ inches



Sew a pair to each side of the quarter triangle squares




Add green squares to both ends of two of the strips, and sew these around the centre square. The square should now measure 12 ½ inches



Make four flying geese with the small background rectangles and the purple connectors.



Add connector corners to the remaining background rectangles in pairs:



Sew one pair to each flying goose, then add dark blue squares to two of the resulting borders.



Add the borders to the block and you are done!
