

# Block of the Month Settings – 2010

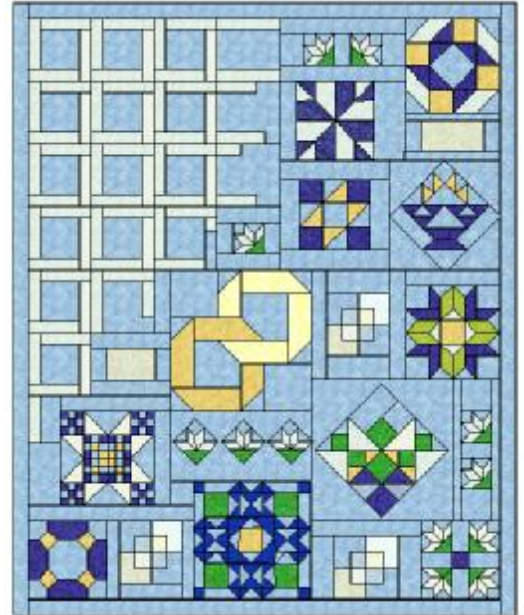
We have done three different settings that may appeal to you – or you can do the blocks and arrange them for your own unique quilt. The material list is approximate, but should give you enough to complete the quilt as shown

## **The Wedding Story – size 64 inches by 78 inches**

We used a total of 4.5 – 5 m of background including the border and binding cut lengthwise.

We also used 0.4 metres each of lace and jacquard for the woven ribbons and fillers



## **The Apple Cider Quilt – 56 by 60 inches**

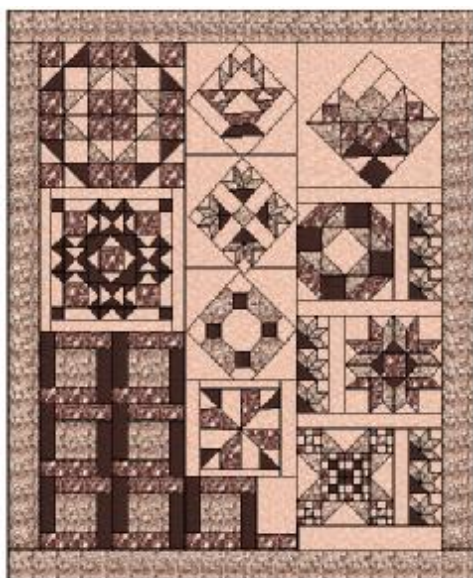
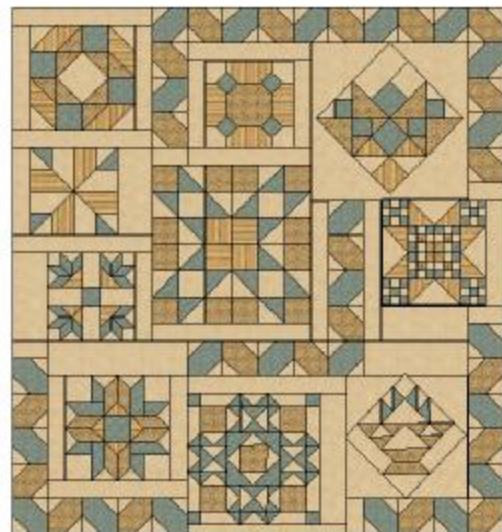
This quilt has prints of blue apples and a very neat stripe that we used in the zig zag border

For this one, **in addition to what you need for the blocks** you need:

Background + 1.5 m (includes binding)

Borders + 0.3 of two of the block fabrics

Also, we only used three fabrics in all.



## **The Art Deco Quilt – size 58 by 71.**

This is done in two Art deco prints in pink and brown, plus the background and a solid brown.

We used an additional 1.0 metre of background, and a total of 2 metres for the border and binding which included completing all the blocks. You will need an additional 0.2 for each of the ribbons.
