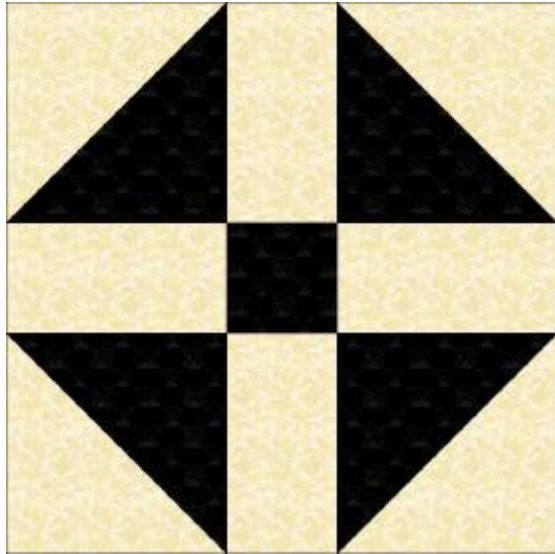


Shoo Fly Block

10 inches finished
10 ½ inches edge to edge



Cutting:
Centre:



2 ½ inch square



2 ½ by 4 ½ inches

Corners:



2 - 4 7/8 inch squares cut diagonally once
Or 4 triangles cut from 4 ½ inch strip using Half Square
or Easy Angle ruler



2 - 4 7/8 inch squares cut diagonally once
Or 4 triangles cut from 4 ½ inch strip using Half Square
or Easy Angle ruler

This is a simple nine-patch. Sew the triangles together for the four corners, lay the pieces out in the nine-patch as shown.

Chain and Knot Variation

10 inches finished
10 ½ inches edge to edge



This block will be fun to play with. The chain could be made from one or two different colours - usually the colours will be dark so that you can see the diagonal in the finished quilt.

You could make the centre nine-patch a different colour from the corners. You could try some transparency, You can eliminate some of the lines for a simpler block if you wish.

Use the same light fabric as the light in the Shoo Fly block for continuity.

The block is made up of 2 ½ inch squares, and 2 ½ inch four patches.

For the four patches (corners and centre), use 1 ½ inch squares.
