
# **Autumn Splendour Shoulder Bag**

For easy identification each fabric is labeled from A-E. The instructions refer to each fabric according to its label.

Tip: Label pieces as you cut them for easy identification

### Useful presser feet for the variety of techniques used in the creation of Autumn Splendour:

Pin-tuck foot

Edge stitch foot

Couching foot

1/4" Patchwork foot

Walking foot

Free-motion or darning foot

**Please note:** If you don't have any or all of the above presser feet you can still create this project. The above mentioned presser feet are precisely designed for specific techniques and will make a beautiful result easier to achieve.

## Please bring to class:

Sewing machine including presser feet, foot control and cord

Homework

Basic sewing supplies

Size 80 and 90 Microtex and 80 and 90 Metallic needles if working with metallic threads

Dressmakers zipper 12" with plastic teeth

Roxanne's Glue-Baste-It! (Optional but I don't sew without it)

Glue stick (Optional yet very handy when sewing the zipper)

Twin needles 80/2.0

505 temporary adhesive (Optional for bonding bottom fabric with canvas)

50/2, 100% cotton to blend with fabrics

\*Decorative threads for stitching through the needle that match, enhance and blend with fabrics

\*Decorative cords for couching that match, enhance and blend with fabrics

### \*Please see description with \* below

# If adding beads to your bag please bring the following:

Beads: 150+size 6 glass seed beads Tweezers (Optional for positioning beads) Sulky, polyester, invisible thread

Glad Press'n Seal

### \*Thread stitched with size 80/12 Microtex needle:

DMC 100% cotton 50/2 weight, Aurifil 100% cotton 50/2 weight, Mettler 100% cotton 60/2, 50/2, Marathon or Sulky Rayon 40/2 weight or Polyester in above weights.

### \*Thread stitched with size 90/14 Microtex needle:

Sulky Blendables 100% cotton 30/2 weight, Valdani 100% Cotton 40/2 weight, Mettler 100% Cotton 50/3, 40/3 or Polyester in above weights.

### \*Decorative cords for couching:

Decorative cords from narrow to thick that match or enhance the fabrics.

**Note:** These cords can be smooth, lumpy or both. You are the artist you get to make the decisions.
