## Cutting Instructions:

Dark Pink: Cut 1 strip 3 1/2"x WOF (you need 40" total)

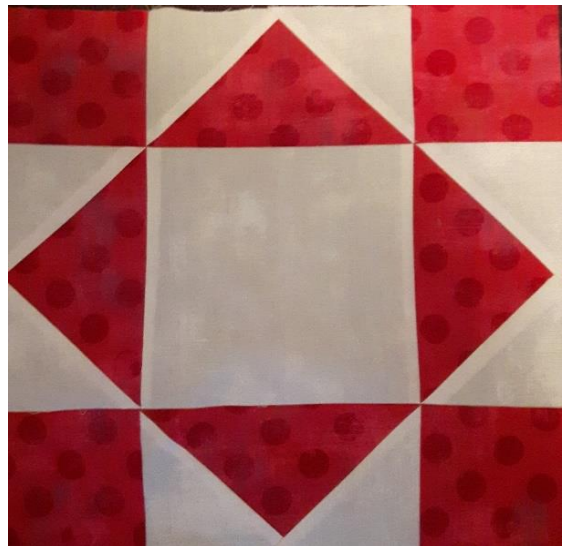
Subcut: 4 each 3 1/2" squares and

4 each 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

White/offwhite background: cut 1 strip 6 1/2" x WOF

Subcut: 1 each 6 1/2" square and

8 each of 3 1/2" squares.



## Flying geese: Make 4

You will need 1 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle (Pink) and 2 - 3 1/2" squares (white) to make each unit.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 3 1/2" square. This is your sewing line. Lay this square right sides together on your rectangle, Step 1, and sew on the line. Trim off excess as shown in picture, Step 2 and the press open, Step 3. Repeat these steps for the other side as shown in Step 4 & 5. Square to 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" with the point being 1/4" in from the side.

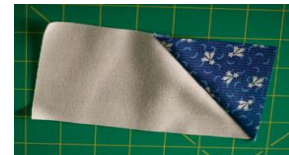

Layout your pieces as per picture at top of page and sew together. Press to a direction that results in less bulk. Sometimes opening a seam makes less bulk. Your choice.

Square to 12 1/2"
