

CHAINS

What you need:

White Solid: Cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF
subcut: 4 each of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
4 each of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

Red Solid: Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF
(xmas red) subcut: 1 each $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square
8 each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



Putting it together:

Layout all of your pieces for the block as per picture Fig. 1 below. First stitch the center 9 patch together as you would for any other 9 patch. Stitch the 2 white pieces to the sides of this 9 patch. Piece the red squares to either end of the remaining longer white pieces and then join them to the top and bottom of the previously sewn unit. see Fig. 2 below.

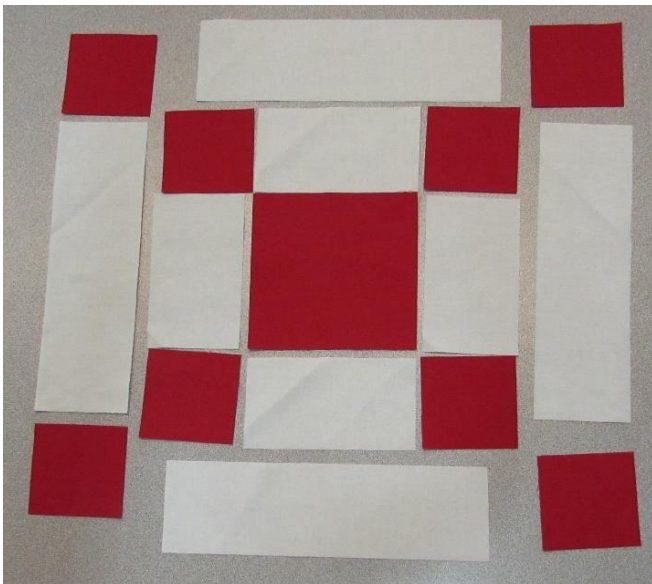
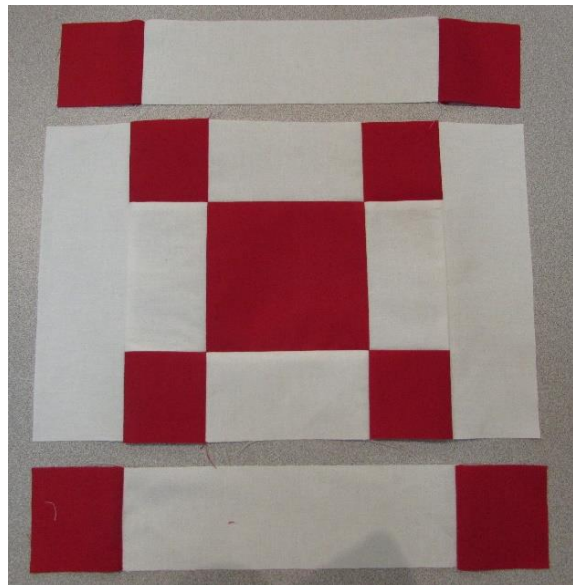
