

Side Nine Patch

Cutting instructions:

White: 1 strip 2" x WOF
Subcut: 5 each 2" squares
1 piece 2" x 17" and keep the remainder

Black Print: Cut 1 strip 2" x WOF
Subcut: 4 each 2" squares
1 piece 2" x 18" and keep the remainder

Pink Print: Cut 2 strips 2" x WOF
Subcut 2 each 2" x 17", 1 each 2" x 15" and
1 each 2" x 9"



Instructions:

Nine Patch: Create your nine patch with the 5 white 2" squares and the 4 black 2" squares as per picture. Press to the black.

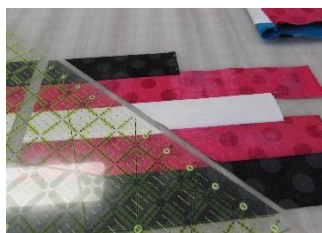
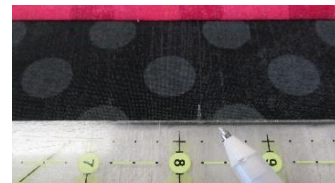


Strata 1: Create a strata using the 2 pink 2" x 17" and the 1 white 2" x 17". Pictured to the right

subcut this strata to 2 units of 5 1/4" x 8". Press to the dark.



Strata 2: Sew the remaining 2" strips together on long side a , centering each one to the previous one, in the following order. Black, Pink, White, Pink, Black. Find the center of this strata and cut a straight line across all fabrics. From this cut line measure 8 1/2" and mark your fabric on both pieces. Lay your 45 degree line along the bottom of your strata and move the edge of the ruler to the mark. Trim your piece and repeat for the other side turning your ruler to use the opposite 45 degree line. See pictures. Press the seams in opposite directions before sewing together. Sew the pieces together as per picture. This unit should measure 8" square.



Layout your blocks per picture to the right.
Sew together in rows. Then sew rows
together.

Square to 12 1/2"
