
Combinations of these two blocks may be ideal for the February Baby Quilt Challenge. Participants are asked to make at least one of each block and will get one ticket for each block made. A draw will be made for each group of 16 blocks. Both blocks use foundation piecing techniques. If you are unfamiliar with this method, there are many tutorials on line and in books which describe how to do foundation piecing. It is fast, easy and accurate.

Butterfly Block:



Techniques: Paper piecing and machine applique

Fabrics: Pastel or medium solid for background and two coordinating

bright prints for the wing units.

Coordinating darker fabric for the applique of the butterfly body.

Method: Use the foundation pattern to construct the block.

Trace the butterfly body onto fusible transfer web or use applique technique of your choice. Then

machine applique in place. Embroider antennae using a stitch and color of your choice
