

Crazy One



Did you ever want to play around with all those fancy stitches on your sewing machine but didn't have a purpose? Then try making this crazy quilt block once, twice or even three times!

Trace the pattern onto a 6 inch square of stabilizer or medium weight interfacing then using foundation piecing methods, construct the block.

A1 should be from a light print and fussy cut to highlight a flower or vintage like print. Remaining pieces (A2 to A8) should be jewel tone prints and one may be black or another dark solid.

Once constructed use fancy stitches in interesting thread colors or weights along or on top of some seams. Use bits of trim or braid on other seams. Add beads, buttons, lace, or hand embroidered motifs.
