



X Marks the Spot

Fabric Cutting:

Background - Cut 2 strips of 2 1/2" x WOF

Print - Cut 2 strips of 2 1/2" x WOF

Sewing Instructions:



1a

1. Sew all 4 strips together on the long edge (selvege to selvege) as pictured above.

2. Line up the 45° line along the bottom edge of the strip 2a and adjust the ruler as far to the right as possible and trim. 2b

3. Shift ruler to line up the opposite 45° line along the bottom edge 3a. Shift the ruler so the 1/4" mark is at the intersection of strip 1 and 2 from the top. See picture 3b. Then trim to complete the triangle 3c. The small piece at the tip can be removed.



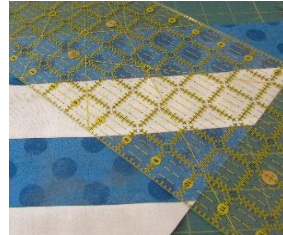

4. Now will you need an opposite triangle so shift your ruler to the top of the strip set with your 45° lined up on the top edge 4a. Again shift the ruler so the 1/4" mark is at the intersection of strip 3 and 4 from the top 4b. Trim.

You will need to repeat the above procedures so you end up with 4 triangles. You should have 2 triangles with your background on the larger outside strip and 2 with the printed fabric on the larger outside strip. Layout these triangles as per picture at the top and sew together. unfinished size will be 12 1/2"
