Snail's Trail

Cutting Instructions:

Cut the same from each - White & Turquoise print

1 - 7" strip x WOF


Subcut: 1 -7" square - cut once diagonally


1 - 5 1/4" square - cut once diagonally 1 - 4 1/4" square - cut once diagonally

2 - 2 3/4" squares

Centre unit (4 patch):

Using your 2 3/4" square, create a 4 patch block. Square to 4 3/4". Press to darker fabric.





Adding the Triangles

Take the two white triangles (from the 4 1/4" square) and add them to your 4 patch. Note the orientation of the 4 patch in the picture. Centre the point along the seam line of the 4 patch so you know it will be centred over the edge. Press to Triangle. Repeat with the turquoise print. Square to 6 1/2".







Next round you will use the triangles from the 5 1/4" square and repeat as above. Again note the orientation of the 4 patch when adding your next triangle. It doesn't matter which colour you put on first. Press to triangle. Square to 9"



Last round you will use the triangles from the 7" square and repeat as above. Again note the orientation of the 4 patch when adding your next triangle. It doesn't matter which colour you put on first. Press to triangle. Square to 12 1/2"
