

Hourglass Modified

Cutting instructions:

- 1 each 5" square of 2 (two) Childrens' print fabrics (to make hourglass)
- 2 each 5" squares of coordinating print (orange in picture)

Black & White

- 1 each 7" square of solid black
- 1 each 7" square of solid white



Construction of block:

Putting right sides together, match your 2 coordinating print 5" squares with each of your Childrens prints. Draw a diagonal line and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on either side of the line. (See picture 1A). Cut and press. You will have 4 half square triangles and each one should have a coordinating print and a childrens print in it. (see picture 2A) Square these to $4\frac{3}{4}$ " and sew together as you would a four patch block. See picture above for layout. Once sewn together this four patch should measure 9" square.

Take your 2 - 7" Black & white squares and cut once diagonally. Centre your black triangle on one side of the previously completed section. See picture 3A as to where the point should be for centering. Attach the black triangles to opposite sides and the white triangles to the other two sides. Press & square up to $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
