### Flower Power (12" finished)

#### Technique: Curved piecing (Drunkards Path)

Go wild, go crazy!! **Bold and beautiful prints** are what make this block shine!! Please select your fabrics in light, med, and dark tones of: purple, yellow, orange, red, blue, pink and green. You can use all one color or mix it up, you can even add a colored solid or two. Have fun with it!!

#### Cut:

**Note: Templates are used to make drunkards path square: ( 4" and 5" are the minimum size of square needed to cut template)**

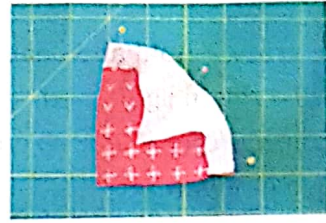
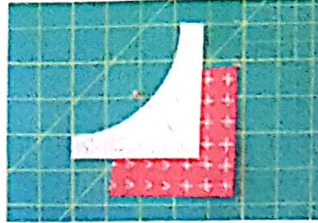
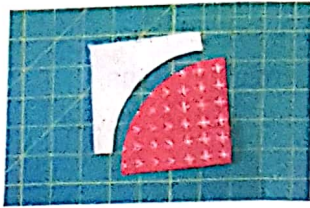
Template K: cut 8 from bold prints (4" squares)

Template L: **Must be white** (can be tone on tone) cut 8 (5" squares)

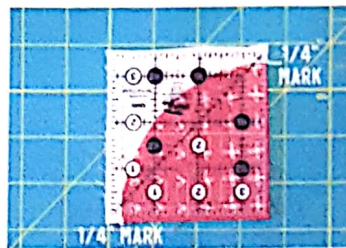
Cut 8 - 3 1/2" squares from bold prints

**Piecing:**

1. See illustrations for how template K and L are sewn together, if you need additional help go to link for tutorials, they show 2 methods! **Trim:** True up to 3 1/2" square, you should have 1/4" on either side of quarter circle.



2. Arrange squares placing the curved blocks according to picture of my block. Sew together using 1/4" seam allowance. Press to dark and all seams to one side for easy nesting!
