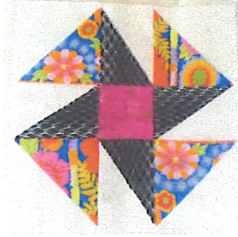

Technique: HST and HRT



12"

Cut:

2 - 6" White Squares

2 - 6" Colorful Print Squares

1 - 3 1/2" Square Contrasting Colorful Print that reads as a solid

2 - 4 1/2" X 6" White Rectangles

2 - 4 1/2" X 6" Black and White Print (black is dominant)

Piece:

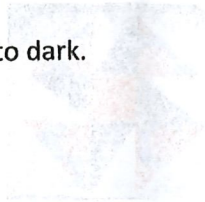
HST:

1. Place white and printed squares right sides together. Mark 45 degree line on white. Sew a scant 1/4" on either side of line. Cut apart on drawn line.



2. Press to set seam then press seam to dark.

3. True square to 5" square.



HRT:



4. Mark a diagonal line from the top right corner to bottom left corner on both white rectangles. (right sided angle)
5. Place white rectangles on top of B/W rectangles right sides together. Rotate the top right corner of the white rectangle to the left top corner of the B/W rectangle. Ensure that the opposite bottom corners are also aligned.
6. Sew a scant $1/4$ " on either side of drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line.
7. Press to set seam then press seam to dark.
8. True up rectangle to $3\ 1/2$ " X 5 " (* tip: make a $3\ 1/2$ " X 5 " template using freezer paper, mark diagonal line as described in step 4. Align drawn line to block, press to block and trim around template.)

Assemble:

9. **Nine Patch:** Arrange HST, HRT and center square according to pic and sew together.
