Mightly Stars (Friendship Star)

Technique: Partial seams and corner square triangles



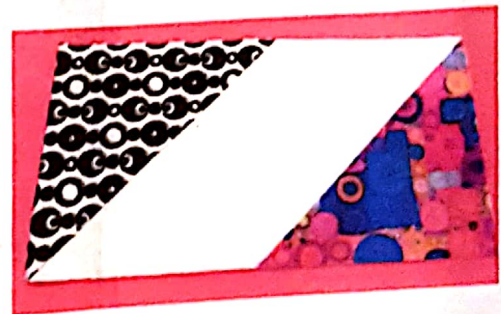
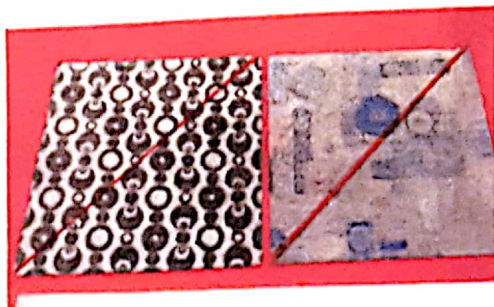
Finished 12" Block

Cut:

- 4 - 4 1/2" B/W print (black being dominant)
- 4 - 4 1/2" Colorful solid (tone on tone is fine)
- 1 - 4 1/2" Fussy cut colorful floral (center)
- 4 - 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" White solid (tone on tone is fine)

Piece:

1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of all B/W and colorful prints squares (except center).
2. Lay out according to pic on left, paying attention that the angles on both square are going to the right. Sew slightly to the right of the marked line and trim. (**Tip: I sew another line to the right of my first seam and cut between leaving me with smaller HST ready for another project!)



3. Place center square on top of first rectangle. Seam 1 is your partial seam, start stitching at the arrow .



4. Press seam partial seam and attach rectangle 2. Continue adding the remaining 2 rectangles in same manner finishing with the remainder of your partial seam.
