

Blue Mountain Quilt Guild
The House that Scraps Built
October 2019 Block of the Month

Finished Block 10 ½ in.

Material list

Centre - 16 in square or material centre provided (Dark Blue)

Strips in a variety of widths no larger than 2 ½ inches or smaller than 1 ½ inch.

Colour choice is yours.

1. Use the material centre that is supplied or cut one from the template provided.
2. Orient the centre with the flat side opposite the peak so that the flat side is on the bottom.
3. Build the 'house' as you would a log cabin block starting with a strip of fabric on the bottom edge. No need to cut the strip to length before hand.
4. After the first strip is sewn on, simply cut it to match the length of the bottom edge.
5. Continue building your house, sewing the strips on in a counter clockwise direction. Using a variety of widths and colours of strips build the house until it is large enough to cut a 10 ½ in. square out of the pieced block. . As each strip is sewn on, cut it to match the length of the side it is sewn on.
6. You will need to build up the peak edges of the house with more strips in order to cut out a 10 ½ in. square.
7. You are finished.
