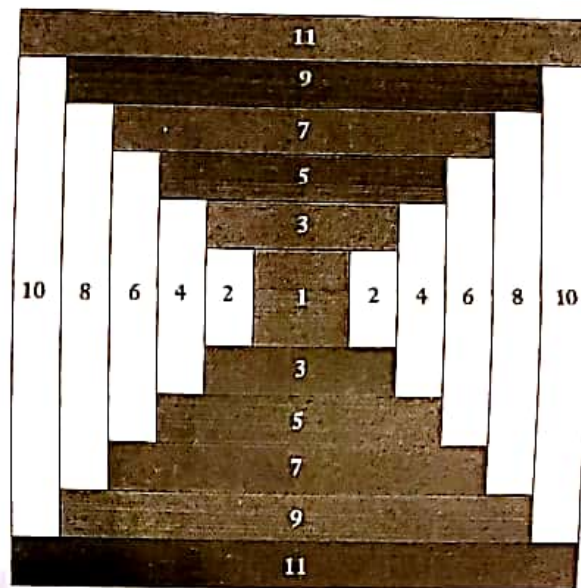


LOG CABIN VARIATION – "COURTHOUSE STEPS"
(Block is 12 inches square)



Courthouse Steps Block—Make 64.

1. For each Courthouse Steps Block, select 1 center square (traditionally RED was used for the center), 5 light fabric strips and 5 dark fabric strips. Cut $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric. The colors used for the blocks should be in "Blues or Greens"
2. Sew light strips (#2) to opposite sides of center square (Court house strips Block Diagram). Press seam allowances toward strips and trim ends of strip even with square
3. Sew dark strips (#3) to opposite sides of center unit. Press seam allowances toward dark strips and trim ends of strip even with center unit.
4. Continue adding logs in this manner always pressing seam allowances toward newest log.
5. Make 64 of these blocks if you are going to make it into a quilt. Quilt size finished 96 in. x 96 inches.
6. Quilt as desired - Make binding, cut 11 yards of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide bias or straight grain binding, Apply binding to quilt edges.....
