

Finished Size: 46½" × 59½"

LITTLE SCRAPPY

Use leftovers from scrappy quilt on page 56 or your favorite method of making triangle-squares if you just want to make this quilt.

MATERIALS

154 leftover triangle-squares (or 154
(4¼") triangle-squares)
½ yard blue print for binding
3 yards backing fabric
Twin-size quilt batting

CUTTING

Measurements include ¼" seam
allowances

FROM BLUE PRINT, CUT:

- 6 (2½"-wide) strips for binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out triangle-squares as shown in *Quilt Top Assembly Diagram* on page 61.
2. Join into rows; join rows to complete quilt top.

Directions for Making Half Square Triangles (HST)

Materials : 9 - 5 inch squares of solid fabric

9 – 5 inch squares of patterned fabric

1. Lay 1 solid colour 5 inch square on top of 1 patterned 5 inch square, right sides together (rst)
2. On the wrong side of the lightest fabric draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. On either side of this line draw a second line a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch away. These are the lines that you will sew on.
3. Sew along the 2 diagonal lines. Then press the sewn square.
(Hint if your machine 'eats' the corners of the square place a piece of issue paper underneath the corner of the square and begin sewing on the tissue paper.)
4. Cut apart the square on the first line that was drawn. Then press the finished HST.
5. Square HST to $4\frac{1}{4}$ inches
6. Repeat for all remaining squares.
7. You will have 9 finished HST's

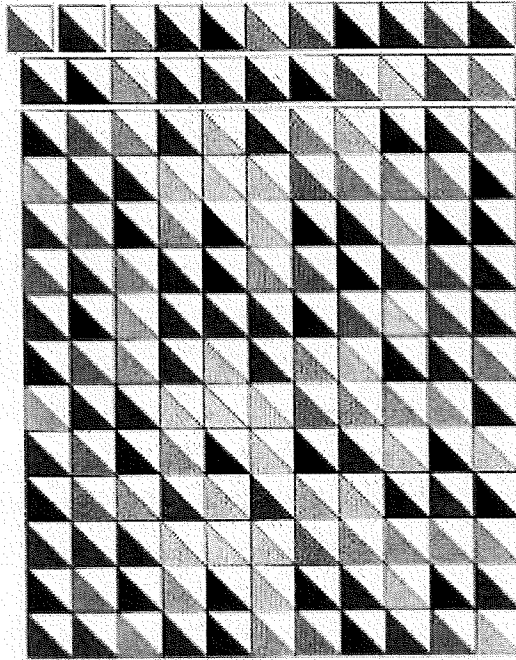
Completing the Block

The finished square is a nine patch. Lay out the completed HST's 3 squares across (row) by 3 squares down (column)

1. Sew each of the rows together.
2. Sew each of the rows together to complete the finished Block.
3. Press and square block to $11\frac{3}{4}$ inches

FINISHING

1. Divide backing into 2 (1½-yard) lengths. Join pieces lengthwise. Seam will run horizontally.
2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired.
3. Join (2½"-wide) blue print strips into 1 continuous piece for straight-grain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt. ♦
