

January BOM Anything Goes Scrappy Strips



Cutting: (Makes 2 blocks)

Subcut 1 ¼" wide X WOF(Black strip provided by Guild) into 4 8 1/2" long strips.

13 - 1" X 18" strips of Anything Goes Prints or Solids (Subcut into 26 - 1" X 9" Strips)

Directions:

- Starch fabric or strips prior to cutting for optimal and accurate cutting.
- Arrange 13 strips in a pleasing manner from your mixed prints and solids.
- Separate into 4 groups of 3. *(last set will have 4)*



- Sew 3 strips together using a scant ¼" seam allowance, alternate the direction you sew each strip to avoid adding a curve to your strip sets. The middle strip should measure ½" once sewn, if it is off then you can adjust your seam allowance before you sew the next set. Continue until you have sewn all 4 strip sets. Press all seams to one side each time you sew. Press all seams in the same direction.



- Sew 2 sets of three together in the same manner, alternating direction and pressing to one side

-Join last set together.



- Starch and press, ensuring no little folds within seams!! Should measure 7" wide, trim length to 8 ½".

- Add the 2- Black 1 ¼" W X 8 ½"L strips to both of the sides of the pieced strips.

- Finished block should measure 8 ½" square, make 2 for Guild.
