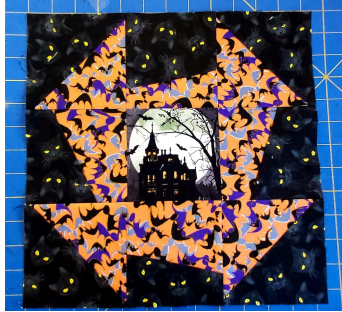


October BOM

Wonky Halloween Churn and Dash



Cut:

1- 4 1/2" Fussy cut Halloween Print

Black Halloween Print: (can have other colors but should read black)

2 - 5 1/2" Squares

1 - 4" X 22" strip

Orange Halloween Print: (can have other colors but should read orange)

2 - 5 1/2" Squares

1 - 4" X 22" strip

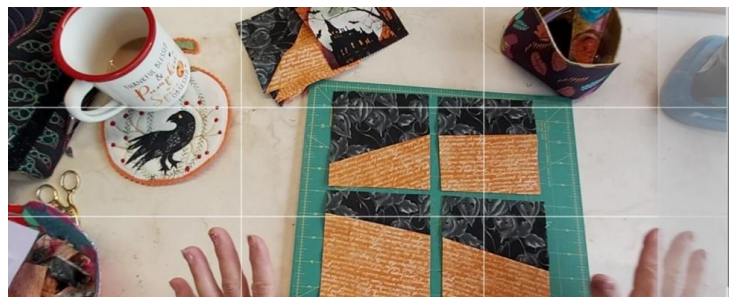
Assemble:

1. Make 4 Hst's: Mark a 45 degree line on the WS of both Orange 5 1/2" squares. Place RS together with the 2 black 5 1/2" squares. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on either side of the marked line. Cut apart on marked line. You will now have 4 Hst's. Press to the dark and true up to 4 1/2" square.



2. Sew the orange and black strips together using a 1/4" seam. Press to the dark. Using a 4 1/2" ruler or Paper template cut 4 - 4 1/2" wonky squares. **Angle the template/ruler in different directions. Also, you will have lots of width to move the template/ruler up and down so that you can get different/odd amounts of orange or black on either side of the seam.

You want them all to be different looking, thus the wonky part!! See pics below**



3. Arrange squares into a nine patch. See pic for placement. Sew together in 3 horizontal rows. Press row 1 and 3 seams inwards. Press row 2 seams outward. Make sure strips measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".



4. Join the 3 rows nesting the seams. Press the seams lightly towards the center, swirl seams to distribute the bulk. Press with starch, true up block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
