
Cutting List:



- 4 5" Squares (solid color of your choice) (Petals)
- 2 3 1/2" Squares (green tone on tone print) (Leaves)
- 1 3" Square (gold/yellow tone on tone) (flower center) **subcut into 4 1 1/2" squares**
- 1 1" X 6" Strip of green (stem)
- 1 4" Square (white tone on tone) **subcut into 4 2" squares**
- 2 3 ¹/₂" X 9 ¹/₂" Rectangles (white tone on tone)
- 1 3 1/2" Square (white tone on tone)

Assemble:

1. Mark a 45 degree line on the ws of all of the squares, except the 5" petal squares.



Place a white 2" square on the upper left corner of 1 - 5" petal square and 1 - 1 ¹/₂" yellow square on the upper right corner. Match placement and 45 degree angles as pictured below. Sew on marked line, trim to a ¹/₄" seam allowance. Make 3 more exactly like this. Press gold seams in opposing directions for easy nesting.




3. Sew together in a 4 patch as pictured. Swirl the center seam to reduce bulk. True to 9 ½" square.




4. Place a green 3 ¹/₂" square on one end of the 3 ¹/₂" X 9 ¹/₂" rectangle rs together. Match placement and 45 degree angle as pictured below. Sew on marker line and trim to ¹/₄" seam. Press to the dark Repeat for the other side. The 45 degrees angle will be in the opposite direction.



5. Cut the white 3 ½" square on the marked 45 degree angle. Place one triangle RS together centered on the green 1" X 6" green strip. Sew a ¼" seam. Finger press in half and line up the other triangle placing rs together, sew 1/4" seam. True up square to 3 ½" square. I pressed the seams to the dark.



6. Arrange components as pictured below and sew together using a ¹/₄" seam allowance.



7. True block to 12 ¹/₂" square.
