

Purple Path Block– BMQG October 2024

Block of the month – Unfinished block **11” square**



Scant 1/4” seams – if your seams tend to be wider, cut the fabric pieces 1/8” larger to obtain the correct dimensions.

This block requires 5 different purple fabrics ranging dark to light in addition to white solid or low volume.

- Cut 1 White (low volume or solid) square - 5 3/4" square (A)
- Cut 2 medium purples squares – 3 1/8" squares (B)
- Cut 4 dark purple squares – 3 1/8" squares (C)
- Cut 3 medium dark purple squares - 3 1/8" squares (D)
- Cut 2 medium light purple squares - 3 1/8" squares (E)
- Cut 1 light purple square - 3 1/8" squares (F)

Sew a C square to a B square. Sew a D square to a C square. Sew the two segments together to create a 4 patch with the CB at the top and the DC at the bottom of the 4 patch. Repeat.

Sew an E square to a D square. Sew the F square to the remaining E square. Sew a 4 patch with ED at the top and the FE at the bottom.



Sew the top left 4 patch to the white square. Sew the remaining 4 patches together keeping the layout as above (CBDC on the left). Sew the top segment to the bottom segment, ensuring the white square is on the top right of the block.

The block is 11" square unfinished.
