

Patience Block – BMQG December 2024

White, blue and green fabrics – 9 ½” unfinished

Scant ¼” seams – if your seams tend to be wider, cut the fabric pieces 1/8” larger to obtain the correct dimensions.

- Cut 4 White or Cream low volume background squares - 3 ½” squares (all the same low volume fabric)
- Cut 4 Green print rectangles – 2” x 3 ½” (all the same green fabric)
- From Blue print fabric – same fabric for all 4 rectangles
 - Cut 2 Blue print rectangles – 2”x 3 ½”
 - And
 - Cut 2 Blue print rectangles – 2” x 6 ½”



- 1) Sew (1) 2”x 3 ½” blue rectangle to (1) 3 ½” low volume square.
- 2) Sew (1) green rectangle to each side of another 3 ½” low volume square. Add (1) blue 2” x 6 ½” rectangle to the top of the white and green segment



3) Sew the pieces created in steps 1 and 2 as shown in the diagram above and repeat. Sew the 2 pieces to create the block above
