

Winter Crossing Block – BMQG November BOM 2024



Cream, and Red Christmas patterned and Blue solid (or Grunge/tone on tone) fabric – 10 1/2” unfinished

Scant 1/4” seams – if your seams tend to be wider, cut the fabric pieces 1/16 to 1/8” larger to obtain the correct dimensions.

- Cut 4 Cream squares - 3” squares (all the same fabric)
- Cut 4 Red squares – 3” squares (all the same fabric)
- Cut 4 Blue rectangles – 3” by 5 1/2” (same fabric for all 4 rectangles)



For the center of the block, sew a 4 patch by sewing a cream square (A) to a red square (C) twice and then sew the two sections together as in the diagram above (nesting seams).

Sew a blue rectangle (B) to the left and right side of the 4 patch. Keep orientation of the 4 patch as you add the blue (B) rectangles.

Sew a cream (A) and a red (C) square to the short ends of the remaining two blue (B) rectangles as in the block image. Sew an ABC segment to the top of the 4 patch segment and the other ABC to the bottom. Ensure the Cream (A) is in the top left corner and the Red (C) is in the bottom left corner. This block is 10 1/2" unfinished.
