BMQG October 2025 Block of the Month – Railway Ties





12 1/2" Square unfinished

Fabric:

Light Pink solid or mainly pink print

• 4 – 2½ inch x 4½ inch rectangles

White solid, or white grunge or mainly white print

• 9 – 2½ inch x 4½ inch rectangles

Medium or Dark Blue solid or mainly blue print

• 5 – 2½ inch x 4½ inch rectangles

Instructions:

- 1. As per the photos, sew each of the blue and pink rectangles to a white rectangle on the long edge.
 - a. Each "block" should be 4 1/2 inches x 4 1/2 inches.
- 2. Lay out the "blocks starting with a blue set vertically (blue on the left), followed by a pink set (pink on the top) horizontally, then another blue set vertically (blue on the left). Sew the row together.
 - a. This row should measure 12 1/2" wide x 4 1/2" high.
- 3. Lay out the second row with a pink set (pink on the top) horizontally, then another blue set vertically (blue on the left), followed by a pink set (pink on the top) horizontally. Sew the row together.
 - a. This row should measure 12 ½" wide x 4 ½" high.

- 4. Lay out and sew the final row the same as "b" above starting with a blue set.
 - a. This row should measure 12 1/2" wide x 4 1/2" high.
- 5. Sew all three rows together as per the photos. Starting with the top row, sew the squares and rectangles together. Repeat for all 3 rows.
 - a. Press seams to alternate direction so that they can "nest" with the row below.
- 6. Sew the rows together, taking care to line up the squares. Make sure you still have a ¼" seam allowance all around the block.
- 7. Unfinished block should be 12 1/2" square.
