



Mini Christmas Stocking

Cut and Fuse Fabrics (as desired)

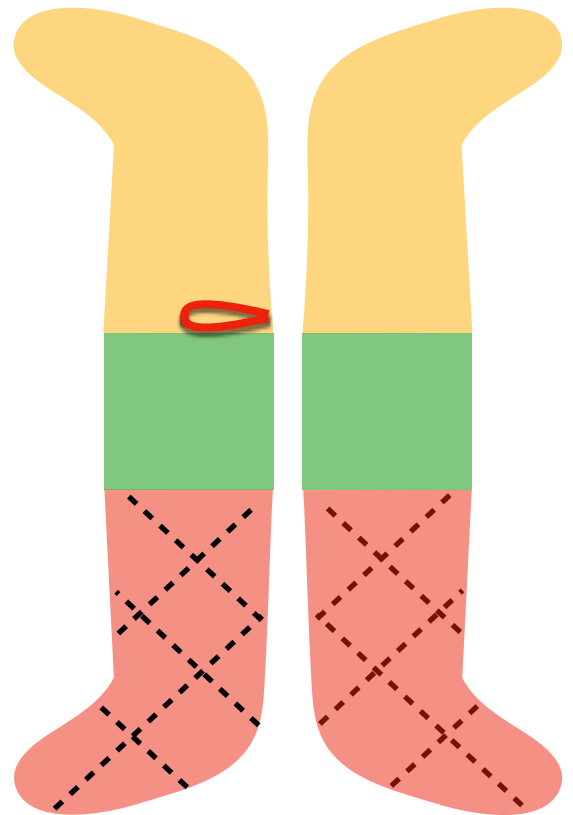
1. Cut [2] exterior and [2] lining fabrics using The Stitchery Studio's free Mini Stocking Pattern. Make sure your pieces are mirrored so you have a left and right side.
2. Cut [2] cuff fabric pieces using cuff template.
3. If you want a stocking with more body or structure use a light fusible interfacing. Fuse the interfacing to wrong side of both stocking exterior pieces. When fusing, place glue dot side of fusible interfacing to wrong side of fabric.

Assemble Stocking

4. With a 1/4" seam allowance sew cuff to top of exterior stocking piece and repeat for other side (see diagram).
5. Sew lining piece top edge to other end of cuff (repeat for other side). Press seam allowances toward stocking piece.
6. Lay one pieced stocking on top of the other, RIGHT sides together, with loop in between (see diagram for loop placement).
7. Pin and sew around outer edge leaving 2" gap in back lining seam to turn through.

Finish

8. Turn right side out through the gap.
9. Press with an iron.
10. Top-stitch or slip stitch opening in lining closed.
11. Tuck the lining into the stocking, and fold cuff down over top of stocking.
12. Press top edge with pressing tools like starch and clapper for crisp finish as desired.
