
## BMQG February 2026 Block of the Month – Framed Pinwheel





12 1/2" Square unfinished

## Fabric:

Light Green print

- 2 5 inch squares
- 4 2 ½ inch squares

Light to Medium Prink print


- 2 5 inch squares
- 4 2½ inch x 8½ inch rectangles

Instructions: Sew all seams a scant 1/4 inch



- 1. Make the 4 half square triangles.
  - a. Line up one green and one pink 5 inch square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the pink 5" square.
  - b. Sew a quarter inch seam allowance on each side of the line you drew.
  - c. Cut the triangles in half along the line.

- d. Press the half square triangles seam towards the darker colored side.
- e. Trim off the corners and square them up with a ruler. (Should be 4.5 inches square)
- f. Repeat with remaining 5" squares.
- 2. Take 2 of the half square triangle and sew them right sides together for the top of the pinwheel watch the direction of the triangles as the pink should be sewn to the green (not 2 pinks to each other). The segment should measure  $8 \frac{1}{2}$  inches wide x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches high).
- 3. Sew the next two half square triangle side by side with the pink and green matching the diagram (should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches x 8 1/2inches).
- 4. Sew the top row of the pinwheel to the bottom segment as per the images, right sides together. Careful not to cut off the tips of the center Tip mark the point with a pen or pin if your seams are covered so you can see the point. This segment should measure 8 ½



inches square.

- 5. Sew a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch by 8  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch rectangle to each side of the pinwheel square, right sides together.
- 6. Sew the remaining green 2½ inch squares to each end of two 2½ inch by 8½ inch rectangles. Sew a pink and green segment, right sides together, to the top and bottom of the pinwheel segment to complete the block.
- 7. Unfinished block should measure 12 1/2" square.
