

BMQG April 2026 Block of the Month – Spring Flowers block



9 1/2" Square unfinished

Fabric:

Yellow

- 1 – 3 1/2 inch square

Pink print

- 4 - 3 1/2 inch squares

Green solid or tone on tone


- 2 – 4 inch squares

Blue solid or tone on tone

- 2 – 4 inch squares

Instructions:

1. Make the 4 half square triangles.
 - a. Line up one Green and one Blue 4 inch square – right sides together. Draw a line from corner on the wrong side of the lighter square.
 - b. Sew a quarter inch seam allowance on each side of the line you drew.
 - c. Cut the triangles in half along the line.
 - d. Press the half square triangles seam towards the darker side.



- e. Trim off the “dog ears” and square them up with a ruler. (**Should be 3 ½ inches square**)
- f. Repeat for the next set of 4 inch squares.



2. Starting with the top row, sew the squares and rectangles together in the order as per the photo above. Repeat for all 3 rows. Each row should measure 3 ½ inches by 9 ½ inches.
 - a. Press seams to alternate direction so that they can “nest” with the row below.
3. Sew the rows together, taking care to line up the squares. Make sure you still have a ¼” seam allowance all around the block.
4. Unfinished block should be **9 1/2” square**.
